



# Credit Freeze

A credit freeze, also known as a security freeze, lets you restrict access to your credit report. It enables you to take control of your financial information by preventing the release of your credit score and any detailed reports by the credit reporting agencies, Equifax, Experian and TransUnion.

Keep in mind that a credit freeze won't do anything to protect your existing financial accounts or other identity-related activities that don't require a credit check.
